Mr. James Berisha an airline pilot and instructor from Kosovo republic will leave the shores of Sierra Leone today Monday 20th December 2010 for Liberia after seeing officials of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Corporation.

The purpose of Mr. James visit to the Foreign Affairs Ministry of Sierra Leone was to extend thanks and appreciation to the People and Government of Sierra Leone for recognizing their independence from the republic of Yugoslavia almost 3 years ago.

The Republic of Kosova declared independence on February 17th 2008. A statement from the website reads 'We are honored and humbled that it is our generation that lives to see this day, and we are aware and ready to take up the path that begins from here. Our future is with Europe. Thank you from the bottom of our hearts, for standing by us in the worst of times.'

About 72 out of the 192 United Nations (UN) member countries have formally/Informally recognized the independence of Kosovo. Sierra Leone is a member of these countries and recognized the independence of Kosovo on the 13th June 2008. Twenty two (22) European Union (EU) Member States had also recognized their independence.

Mr. James Berisha, who came by himself with a 4 seat Cessna aircraft with single engine while granting an interview at the Standard Times office on Saturday, said it is now two years he has engaged on flying around the world to countries who had recognized their independence by extending thanks and appreciations to the People and Governments of those countries. apply for membership into the United Nations and have a seat. In Africa ten (10) countries have recognized the independence of Kosovo such as Djibouti, Somalia, Malawi, Mauritania, Swaziland Senegal, Gambia, Sierra Leone, Liberia, and Burkina Faso

Kosovo declared independence on the 17th of February 2008. The small south east European state sits between Albania, Macedonia, Serbia and Montenegro. The capital of the Republic is Prishtina, a city of around 500,000 people. The population of Kosovo exceeds 2 million.

Kosovo is a state that is moving towards European integration, and will eventually become a member of the European Union. Kosovo has historically, culturally and socially been part of Europe. The ancient kingdoms that stood there were at the centre of European history well over 3,000 years ago. Later on, as new world powers emerged and the world changed, again the nations of south east Europe forged the future of this continent.

In more modern times, Kosovo ended up as the least developed part of Yugoslavia, slowly moving towards high unemployment and unequal opportunities for Kosovar Albanians. This, coupled with nationalistic policies that broke up Yugoslavia, culminated in the Kosovo - Serbia war of 1997-1999.

Today, having declared independence, Kosovo has chosen the path towards Europe. Independence, and the explicit and implicit recognition by the world, has helped set Kosovo on the right course.
